CIRCULAR

It is to be informed that the result of National Achievement Survey 2017 which was administered on 13th November 2017 for class 3, 5 and 8 has been released by NCERT and the reports are available on the following web links of NCERT.

All the Heads of Institutions are instructed to download the respective District Report Cards and State Report Card and disseminate the same to the teachers, SMC members and parents for their perusal and information so that they can contribute accordingly.

All Inspecting Officers, Officials from Samagra Shiksha, faculties from DIET & STC and eminent teachers attended the State Level and District Level Consultative meetings to identify the activities to attain the Learning Outcomes through Immediate, Short and Long Term interventions.

To attain the Learning Outcomes and to improve the quality of education, all the Heads of Institutions and teachers are instructed to follow the following necessary instructions.

1. A Hand Book for Learning Outcomes has been issued to all the teachers handling class I to VIII. The teachers should teach the subjects based on the Learning Outcomes. Posters have been displayed in the class rooms and Leaflets have been issued to the parents in the vernacular language also.
2. Learning Objectives have been listed before each chapter for newly introduced Text Books for class I, VI and IX. Teachers should teach each chapter based on the Learning Objectives. The new Text Books contain the QR Codes for downloading the books, video contents and other related e-contents. Teachers can utilize the web links in ICT lab or use Smart phones or tabs with Apps for downloading and showcasing the video contents available in the new Text Books.
3. Weekly test for each subject must be conducted based on the Learning Outcomes and Slow Learners shall be identified for each subject and special coaching/teaching shall be given to the students for attaining the Learning Outcomes. A separate register has to be maintained by subject teachers and monitored by Head of Institutions and Inspecting Officers.

4. To enhance reading habit among the children, age appropriate story books/comic books/magazines shall be provided to the students weekly and children should read a page daily and obtain signature from parents and it should be monitored and registered in a note book by Librarian. If Librarian is not available, then it shall be monitored by Language and English Teacher.
5. Teachers shall utilize the available resources like computers, internet, smart class rooms, projectors, open source e-content (like NROER, e-pathshala, Tamil Nadu virtual text books, DIKSHA, etc), ICT Lab, Science Labs, Language Lab, Science kits, Maths kits, Digital Maps, Reading Corners, Maths Corners, Science Corners, TLM, Print Rich Materials, Library books, Magazines, etc for enhancing the Teaching-Learning process.
6. Teacher shall give daily assignments particularly Maths subject and it shall be duly corrected and signed by the teacher. The Head of Institution shall monitor the daily assignments of the students.
7. Students shall be given daily practice of multiplication tables using the Print rich materials.
8. Head of Institutions shall depute the teachers whenever training is imparted by DIET, STC and Samgra Shiksha. The list of absent teachers will be brought to the notice of the Director of School Education through proper channel.
9. **"Rank Card Day"** shall be observed for each Terminal Examination and the performance of the students shall be shared with the parents.
