GOVERNMENT OF PUDUCHERRY CHIEF SECRETARIAT (EDUCATION)

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Notification No. F. 5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi and in supersession of the Chief Secretariat (Education), Notification issued in G.O. Ms. No. 18, dated 14th March 2008 and published as Supplement to the Gazette No. 14, dated 1st April 2008 save as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group "C" posts of Bal Bhavan Instructor in the Directorate of School Education, Government of Puducherry, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Directorate of School Education, Group "C" posts of Bal Bhavan Instructor Recruitment Rules, 2013.

(2) These rules shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of posts, their classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale.— The number of the said posts, their classification and the Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications.— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.— Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

- (b) Possessing the qualifications prescribed for direct 7 recruits under column (7).
