NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Notification No. F. 5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi and in supersession of the Education Department's Notification issued in No. 19802/SO(E)/77, dated 30th May 1977 and published as Supplement to the Gazette No. 30, dated 26th July 1977 save as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group "C" post of Ship Modelling Instructor-cum-Storekeeper in the National Cadet Corps Headquarters, Directorate of School Education, Government of Puducherry, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Directorate of School Education, Group "C" post of Ship Modelling Instructor-cum-Storekeeper Recruitment Rules, 2013.

(2) These rules shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Number of post, its classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale.*— The number of the said post, its classification and the Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

**RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF SHIP MODELLING INSTRUCTOR-CUM- STOREKEEPER**

1. Name of the post : Ship Modelling Instructor-cum-Storekeeper
2. Number of posts : 1 (One) [2013] Subject to variation dependent on work-load
3. Classification : General Central Services-Group 'C' Non-Gazetted-Non-Ministerial.
4. Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale : PB-1 ₹ 5,200-20,200 + Grade Pay ₹ 2,400
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post : Not applicable
6. Age-limit for direct recruits : Between 18 and 30 years (Upper age-limit relaxable for Government servants up to 40 years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government, provided such Government servants are working for not less than three years in the posts which are in the same line or allied cadres and where a relationship can be established that the services rendered by them in the department will be useful for the efficient discharge of duties in the post for which selection is made.)
- Note* : (1) In the case of recruitment made through advertisement, the crucial date for determining the age shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from the candidates.
- Note* : (2) In the case of recruitment made through Employment Exchange, the crucial date for determining the age-limit shall in each case, be the last date up to which the Employment Exchanges are asked to submit the names.
7. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits : **I. Essential**
- (1) Must have passed Higher Secondary (12th class) or its equivalent.
- (2) Must have undergone a course of study/training in ship modelling of not less than six months in any reputed centre or firm or have at least one year experience in the line.
- (3) At least two years of practical experience as Instructor in English and Hindi. This is subject to relaxation by the recruitment committee if suitable candidate with the experience is not available.
- II. Desirable**
- (1) Aptitude for modelling especially ship models
- (2) Previous experience as a Storekeeper
- (3) A degree in Arts or Science from any recognised University.
- (4) Possessing 'B' or 'C' certificate awarded by the NCC authorities.
- (5) Knowledge of Tamil

*Note* : The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the competent authority in the case of candidates belonging to the scheduled castes or scheduled tribes, if, at any stage of selection, the competent authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

8. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees.	Not applicable
9. Period of probation, if any	Two years
10. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/absorption and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.	By direct recruitment (The candidates selected should furnish security deposit as prescribed by the Government by general or special orders from time to time).
	<i>Note</i> : Vacancies caused by the incumbents being away on deputation or long illness or study leave or under other circumstances for a duration of one year or more may be filled on deputation basis from the officers of Central/State/UT Governments—
	(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or (ii) with five years service in the grade after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in PB-1 ₹ 5,200-20,200 with Grade Pay of ₹ 2,000; or (iii) with eight years service in the grade after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in PB-1 ₹ 5,200-20,200 with Grade Pay of ₹ 1,900; and
	(b) Possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column (7).
