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In continuation of this Office Circular of even number dated 21st November 2019, it is informed that the current year 2019, marks the 70th year of the adoption of the Constitution. It has been directed by MHRD to carry out an awareness campaign with a focus on citizen's duties including fundamental duties as enshrined in the Indian Constitution, from 26th November 2019 to 26th November 2020.

It is therefore requested that programmes and activities may be organized by the Schools of the U.T. of Puducherry as per the Calendar as well as other suggested activities enclosed herewith and the action taken report along with the photos / videos may be uploaded directly from the schools on the following tracker link:

In this connection it is also informed that an online quiz is being organised by MyGov. Hence, it is requested that Students may be encouraged to participate in the Online Quiz in large numbers.

Further it is informed that the Under Signed will act as the Nodal Officer for this programme. The Assistant District Programme Coordinators (ADPC), Samagra Shiksha of the concerned District (Puducherry / Karaikal / Mahe / Yanam) will be the Assistant Nodal Officers and will take up the responsibility of coordinating with the individual schools and MHRD as well Monitor and Report / Upload the status of the initiatives undertaken pertaining to their respective regions in the Mail-id / Web link of MHRD on a monthly basis. The concerned Block Resource Center's (BRC) Coordinators may be the point of Contact for coordination and facilitation in this programme. The composite School Grant may be utilized for conducting the above said programme. Activities undertaken in schools may be shared widely in social media with the hashtag '#itsmyduty'.

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The ADPC of the Puducherry Region (HQ) will consolidate all the activities undertaken and programmes organized by schools in all Four Regions of the U.T. and upload the same in the given Mail -id / Portal / Link of the Department of School Education and Literacy, MHRD, New Delhi, at the end of every month.
