7. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits

(i) Graduate and Post Graduate with at least 50% marks in Post Graduation AND Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from a recognized University

OR

Post Graduate with at least 50% marks and B.A.Ed or B.Sc.Ed. or B.Com.Ed. from a recognized University;

AND

(ii) Should have studied the particular Regional Language (Tamil / Telugu / Malayalam) as one of the subjects in the Secondary level. However, this qualification is not required for the candidates in the discipline of Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, and French.

NOTE-1:-

It is mandatory that **Bachelor's Degree** and **Master's Degree** should be in the same subject as detailed below:

i. Tamil:

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Tamil as main subject.

ii. Telugu

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Telugu as main subject.

iii. Malayalam:

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Malayalam as main subject.

iv. Hindi

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Hindi as main subject.

v. French:

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in French as main subject.

vi. Arabic:

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Arabic as main subject.

vii. <u>Sanskrit:</u>

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Sanskrit as main subject.

viii. English:-

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in English as main subject.

ix. Mathematics:

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Mathematics as main subject.

x. Physics:

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Physics as main subject.

xi. Chemistry:

Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Chemistry as main subject.

xii. Botany Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Botany as main subject xiii. Zoology Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Zoology as main subject xiv. **Home Science** Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Home Science as main subject. **Political Science** Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Political Science as main subject. xvi. **Economics** Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Economics as main subject. xvii. Commerce Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Commerce as main subject. xviii. History Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in History as main subject. xix. Geography Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Geography as main subject. Civica XX. Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Civics as main subject. **Philosophy** Both Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Philosophy as main subject. Note-2:-Degree(s) awarded in different names will be considered provided that they should be certified by the University Competent Authority concerned Degree(s) awarded by them is / are equivalent to the Degree(s) prescribed above. Whether and Age: No age educational qualifications Educational qualification: Yes prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees Period of probation, if any Two years for direct recruits only.



10 Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation /absorption and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.

20% by Direct Recruitment

70% by promotion failing which by Direct Recruitment 10% by promotion through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination failing which by promotion

In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/ absorption, grades from which promotion/ deputation /absorption is to be made

Promotion:-

Trained Graduate Teacher in Level:7 in pay matrix with two years regular service in the grade

Limited Departmental Competitive Examination:-

Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for promotion is limited to Trained Graduate Teacher in Level:7 in the Pay Matrix, with two years regular service in the grade.

<u>NOTE-1</u>: Only those Trained Graduate Teachers who opted for promotion to the post of Lecturer will be considered for promotion.

<u>NOTE-2:</u> The educational qualification shall continue to be same for the persons holding the feeder grade posts on regular basis on the date of notification of the Revised Rules.

NOTE-3: The incumbents holding the feeder cadre post (i.e) Trained Graduate Teacher on the date of issue of notification of Revised Rules, who have not studied the Particular Regional Language Tamil / Telugu / Malayalam as one the subjects in the Secondary level are also be considered as eligible for promotion, if they have studied the Particular regional Language (Tamil / Telugu / Malayalam) as one of the subjects in the D.T.Ed. Course or in the Bachelor's Degree or in Degree in Teacher Education or studied Diploma in Teacher Education with Tamil / Telugu / Malayalam as medium of instructions.

NOTE-4: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered, provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying /eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying /eligibility service or two years whichever is less and have successfully completed probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying /eligibility service.
