ORDER

Whereas consequent to the steep decline in the number of COVID-19 cases across the country including the U.T. of Puducherry and in pursuance of the Ministry of Home Affairs letter D.O. 40-3/2020/-DM-I(A) dated 22/03/2022, various restrictions imposed had been rescinded. However, wearing of masks, maintaining social distancing, screening and hygiene and frequent hand sanitizing are being continued to be in force vide circular No. No.104/PSEC/COVID19/2022-23 dt. 31-3-2022, in order to keep the situation under control.

And whereas in recent days, the rate of COVID infections is slowly raising and this has attracted the attention of this administration. The continuous spread of COVID-19 necessitates to take prompt and proactive measures at all levels to prevent exponential surge of the disease.

And whereas the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India in their letter D.O.No.T-18015/307/2020-IDSP dated 09/06/2022 has circulated an 'Operational Guidelines for Revised Surveillance Strategy in the context of Covid-19" for wide dissemination down to the field level for collective fight against the pandemic and said Guidelines is available in MoHFW website. The compliance of the Guidelines is to be ensured at all levels besides intensifying vaccination and observing COVID Appropriate Behavior in the U.T. of Puducherry.

And whereas adherence of Covid Appropriate Behaviour, inter-alia plays a major role in containment of spread of Covid-19 disease.

Now therefore, the following instructions/directives are issued under Disaster Management Act, 2005 for strict compliance of Covid Appropriate Behaviour (CAB) by all concerned.

All Administrative Secretaries/Heads of Depts/Offices of all Government depts./offices/PSUs/Board/Corporation etc. shall maintain and monitor CAB at work places. Health department shall follow all instructions/guidelines issued by MoHFW, from time to time and ensure 100% vacination. The Educational Institutions shall scrupulously follow Standard Operating Procedures and shall function as per the directions of the Directorate of School Education/ Dte. of Higher and Technical Education.

The public shall strictly adhere to COVID Appropriate Behavior (CAB) at places of public gathering, Market places etc. At Beach Road/Parks/Gardens the walkers shall compulsorily wear masks and maintain social distancing norms

All Private business/commercial establishments shall operate but shall ensure 100% vaccination. All owners and persons working in shops, business establishments, commercial establishments, Cinema Theatres, Malls, Hotels, Bars, Restaurants, Liquor shops, Hospitality sector, Transport sector etc. shall operate/ function by strictly following the COVID appropriate behavior. They shall follow the Covid Appropriate Behaviour for effective COVID Management.

The field level functionaries such as Health, Police, Revenue, LAD, Labour etc. shall strictly warn, without creating any panic, to wearing of mask, maintaining social distancing and following COVID appropriate behavior at all places of public gathering. Required numbers of Monitoring Teams shall be constituted at their department level.

The District Administration shall hold periodic meeting with the Association of Traders/Resuartants/Hotels/Industries and such other person/bodies and sensitize them about the adherence to norms of Covid Appropriate Behaviour.

The Regional Administration may align local restrictions in the area under their jurisdiction in keeping with restrictions in neighboring states/districts for the sake of better Covid management.

In the event of violations, a report on such violation shall be recorded and the daily list of such violation shall be intimated to the District Collectors for record and further course of action.

This Order supersedes the above said Circular dated. 31.03.2022 and comes to force with immediate effect.
