RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHER (SPECIAL EDUCATION)

1.	Name of the post	: Trained Graduate Teacher (Special Education)
2.	Number of posts	: 160 (2025)* (Tentative)
3.	Classification	: General Central Services - Group 'B' - Non-Gazetted - Non-Ministerial.
4.	Scale of pay	: Level 7
5.	Whether selection post or non-Selection post	: Selection post
6.	Age limit for direct recruits	: Not exceeding 30 years. Relaxable for Government servants up to five years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government. Note: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim Ladakh UT, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep).
7.	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits	: 1. Graduation Degree from a recognized University/ Institute. 2. B.Ed (Special Education); OR B.Ed (General) with one year Diploma in Special Education; OR B.Ed (General) with two years Diploma in Special Education; OR B.Ed (General) with Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education (PGPD): OR B.Ed Special Education and Post graduate professional Certificate in Special Education (PGPC); OR PG Diploma in Special Education (Mental Retardation)

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disability: Physical and | Neurological).

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Locomotor impairment and Cerebral Palsy):

Secondary Level Teacher Training Course in Visual Impairment;

Senior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf:

BA B. Ed in Visual Impairment.

3. Qualified in any one of the Teacher Eligibility Tests CTET/ TNTET/ KTET/ APTET (Elementary Stage).

4. Registration with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI).

Note 1:

BA B.Ed. in Visual Impairment being integrated course of graduation and B.Ed. Special Education, separate graduation is not required in the case of candidate possessing BA B.Ed. in Visual Impairment.

Note 2:

Teacher with qualification in single disability area will be encouraged to specialize in other disability areas by undergoing modular courses to take care of wide range of diversities in a General School.

Note 3:

Should have studied regional language as one of the paper in secondary level / Bachelor Degree/B.Ed/ TET .In respect of schools with medium of instructions in French, should have studied Brevet Elementaire de Francais.

Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Competent Authority, for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.
