Sub: RMSA - Girls Empowerment – Inspiration / Motivation camp for girl students of Secondary classes - Reg.

'Women Empowerment' refers to complete emancipation of women from socio-economic shackles of dependency and deprivations. They can play a significant role in the society which is not only important for an equitable society, but also essential to build stronger economies, achieve internationally agreed-upon development goals, and improve the quality of life of women, men, families, and communities.

In this context, RMSA proposes a Two day Adolescent Programme i.e. Inspiration / Motivation camp for girl students of Secondary sections.


The programme shall include the following activities

- I. Importance of Women Empowerment
- II. How Could I Make My School a Sweet, Friendly & Safe School?
- III. Mother's Together programme – Discussion on the Issues and Strategies related to the day to day problems faced by the mothers with their adolescent daughters
- IV. Health Education on Menstrual Hygiene.
- V. Discussion – Disconcerting facts that disturb adolescent girls during Menstruation.
- VI. Counseling session as per need
- VII. Career Guidance for X students
- VIII. Motivating students by renowned and successful persons in the society.
- IX. Speeches by Health, Social welfare, Police Department personnel
- X. Importance of Self Defence.
- XI. Any innovative programme as per requirement.

The Head of Institutions are requested to organise the 2 Day Motivation camp in their school premises itself and all the women teachers may be deputed for organizing the camp. The cooperation of NSS / CSS Coordinators and volunteers may also be requested. The camp may be conducted on Two Saturdays (consecutive or desirable) between 9.am and 4.30.pm and consent letter shall be obtained from parents. Attendance register shall be maintained and Feedback shall be obtained at the end of the camp from participants in the format given overleaf. An amount of Rs. 500 will be released per student for 2 days camp. Hygienic Snacks and Lunch may be provided during the camp and Pamphlets on Empowerment, Personal Hygiene, etc may also be issued to all the students.

A compliance report must be furnished to the undersigned on or before 25th March 2018 along with relevant photographs and feedback forms.
